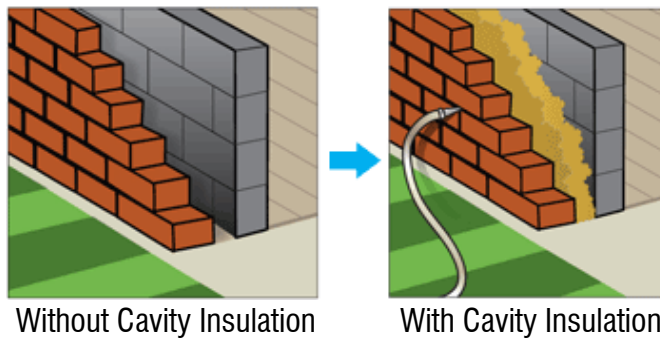

## **What is Cavity Wall Insulation?**

Up to 33%\* of your home's heat can be lost through the spaces between your exterior walls. Cavity wall insulation involves filling this space with insulating material – helping you save energy and making your home feel noticeably warmer. The installation is also guaranteed for 25 years by the Cavity Insulation Guarantee Agency (CIGA)



## **Why do I need it?**

- Cavity wall insulation works by retaining heat making your home more energy efficient
- Cavity wall insulation offers a cost effective solution that will pay for itself time and time again
- A well-insulated house keeps warmth indoors, exactly where you need it
- A non-insulated home loses around a third of its heat through its external walls\*
- Improve your home's energy efficiency rating, which could improve your home value
- Help reduce your impact on the environment

## **The installation process**

The work usually takes 2-3 hours, depending on the size of your home.

- Check your property is eligible for cavity wall insulation, if it is then register with E.ON for a survey.
- One of E.ON's approved surveyors will assess your home to ensure it's suitable for the installation. If it is, a CIGA (Cavity Installation Guarantee Agency) registered company will be assigned to carry out the installation of your cavity wall insulation.
- The installer will make sure that your home's ventilation isn't affected by the insulation and, if necessary, will carry out any work that may be necessary.
- The installer will then drill small holes (about the size of a 10p piece) on the outside walls of your home and inject the insulating material through these holes.



- The holes are then filled and, if necessary, repointing to match the existing wall as closely as possible. Please note; E.ON does not take responsibility for an exact match of colours.
